- 3. All food, produce and paper goods are purchased only from authorized & vetted vendors. All purchased deliveries are inspected and sanitized upon receipt. Vendor's delivery drivers will not be allowed beyond the receiving area of TIME to DINE.
- 4. We have implemented extensive sanitation practices and procedures which includes enhanced training to maintain a safe and hygienic environment for our employees and clients
- 5. Social distancing will be required for all deliveries and events
- 6. You will see your Catering Ambassadors double gloving and wearing masks while delivering and setting up orders.
- 7. By being vigilante, we will constantly and continually provide our best efforts and highest standards to keep the workplace and our clients safe.
